Overview and Eligibility

National Autonomous University of Mexico, Economics Department. Research projects identified as PAPIIT IA302221; IA302022 and PAPIME PE303021.

This Call for Proposals will be open for teachers, researchers from Higher Education Institutions, national and international, and graduate students.

Objective

To generate a space for debate, analysis, and participation of academia, researchers, and graduate students to disseminate and submit for consideration from peers. Advances in work, and/or research results, related to the teaching of economic science and its disciplines. To promote sharing experiences, tools, and methodologies used for teaching in school, free and open and remote modalities.

Session Type Presentation: A 20-minute session presentation over a topic.

- Methodologies for teaching Economics and Finance.
- Experiences, challenges, and learning during the Covid-19 pandemic.
- Financial Education.
- Financial Inclusion
- Educate, empower and train: economists, financiers, and more.
- Information and communication technologies and the teaching of economic science.
- Training the economist as an analyst and researcher.
- Economist apprenticeship and the labor market.
- The social contribution of an economist.
- Teaching economics, finance, and educational innovation.
- Basic skills and competencies of an economist a/or financier.
- Educational contributions to the analysis of the Mexican economy.



- Economics and finance with gender perspective.
- Environmental economics and climate finance.

Application Process

- I. Teachers or researchers from Higher Education Institutions, national or international and graduate students may participate with individual or collective papers submitted by a maximum of three (3) authors.
- II. Research advances and/or results may be presented; sharing teaching experiences in any area of economic science and its disciplines, which contribute to the debate in any of the Primary Focus Areas.
- III. Proposals must be original and unpublished (not having been presented previously or at the same time in other forums).
- IV. Submissions must be received by: 11:59 pm, April 30, 2022 (Mexico City Time. GMT-6). No exceptions will be made on the deadline or document formats. Proposals should be submitted via e-mail to: topicoseconomiayfinanzas.unam@gmail.com. Submission documents must be in PDF format and should have the following structure:
 - Primary Focus Areas (see list in call for proposals).
 - Conference title.
 - Authors' name/s (maximum 3, a certificate will be issued only for presenters). Include institution of affiliation, e-mail, and curriculum vitae (maximum 200 words). (Graduate students, please attach proof of studies).
 - Abstract in Spanish or English, no longer than 250 words.
- V. Option for publication. Once the Colloquium is over, the guidelines to participate in the collective memory of the event will be sent by mail.
